On May 25, **Anne Crocker**, PhD., Director of the Services, policy and population health Research Theme and Assistant Director of the Mental Health Policies and Knowledge Transfer, gave a presentation with her colleagues Michael Seto and Tonia Nicholls, about the National Trajectory Project. The National Trajectory project is examining the changing face of the forensic mental health population and services in Canada. The project, funded through the Mental Health Commission of Canada, is based on an ongoing study in Québec funded by the Fonds de recherche en santé du Québec (FRSQ). It will examine the operation of current criminal justice provisions for individuals declared not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder (NCRMD) and under the authority of a provincial or territorial review board.
