

Graduate Student Training Award – Application Information

Eligibility

1. Is currently enrolled in a graduate program at McGill University.

2. Is supervised by a Member or Associate Member of the SToP-AD Centre.

3. Is involved in research directly related to the Centre's mission.

4. Has applied to Federal and Provincial fellowship agencies and has been unsuccessful in the latest round of applications.

5. Will submit an updated fellowship application to all available fellowship agencies in the next competition.

How to Apply

1. The student must arrange for his/her supervisor to present a Letter of Request addressed to the Director of the SToP-AD Centre. In addition a one-page outline of the students's research project and its relation to the mission of the SToP-AD Centre should be attached to the Letter of Request. 2. The student must submit his/her CV and his/her dossier which has been successfully submitted to one of the recognized fellowship programs available in Canada (i.e. CIHR, NSERC, FRSQ) and is currently under review. This dossier must contain an outline of the project the student will work on during the tenure of his/her award.

3. The student must keep his/her grades in good standing in all courses for the whole duration of the award.

4. At the end of the award the student must submit a two-page Progress Report on the work he/she has completed towards his/her graduate thesis project.
